Dolphin Watersports Safety Instruction Checklist

Required Safety Equipment

Personal Flotation Device – Life Jacket (We provide proper sized devices)

Operational Instruction

Lanyard cutoff switch – Show operation and explain function

Throttle Control – Right side finger lever

Brakes – Release the throttle to stop, water friction

Emergency Radio-show location and operation

Fire extinguisher- show location and operation

Whistle - show location and operation

Operate the Jet Ski defensively - look out for others

Engine off when you are off jet ski

Do not throttle if someone is behind the jet ski

Collision Avoidance – do not drive directly at a fixed object and always look before turning

Avoid aggressive maneuvers and sharp turns.

If You Fall Off Your Jet Ski

Perform a personal assessment to insure you are OK

If you are OK then lift your arm and put your hand on top of your head. This is the "okay" sign to your fellow riders and to our guide!

Get to the jet ski asap – don't let it float away

If the jet ski is upside down, spin it to the right to get the jet ski upright

Grab hold of the handle on the rear of the seat to pull yourself back up and on

If you are hurt and can't get to the jet ski, lay in the water and wait until our guide arrives

Dolphin Watersports Safety Instructions

<u>Rules</u>

No one may operate Jet ski under the influence of drugs/alcohol

No one under the age of 16 may operate the jet ski

No one under 21 may carry an additional rider

Do not ride within 100 feet of any shore line and 50 feet from other watercraft

Avoid obstacles in the water – boats, posts, beach, platform, floating debris, and dolphins

Do not follow directly behind other watercraft

Do not attempt to "splash or spray" any other watercraft

Yield to the right of other watercraft

Must stay in the Edisto River/Botany Bay area (marked with red buoy's)

ALL RULES ARE ZERO TOLERANCE! Immediate cancellation or your ride with no refund will be enforced.
